Cllr Hockin asked the council to consider using the community mini bus as transport, for those people who needed it, to a vaccination centre. One member spoke re the community bus and confirmed it had driver protection and didn't see a reason why it shouldn't be used. Cllr Hockin proposed he look into using the community bus as transport and liaise with the surgery. Seconded by Cllr Simmonds. All in favour.

CCllr advised the council that Volunteer Cornwall had 1800 volunteers who may be able to assist with driving.

The mechanics of communicating by the Parish Council was discussed and with some confusion on what to use to search for the Parish Council website.

Cllr Brewer proposed the council support this application. Seconded by Cllr Edwards. All in favour.

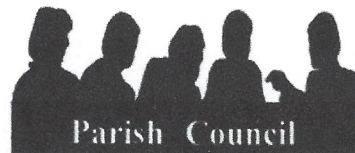
10.05b To consider other planning applications received by time of meeting
