Parish Council Report for year April 2021 – March 2022

Meetings - 18 Parish Council meetings convened

- 12 monthly meetings
- 5 planning and/or Staff & Finance meetings
- 1 Neighbourhood Development Plan
- Councillors also attended many other meetings including Community Network, Neighbourhood Development Plan, along with involvement with Boscastle Chamber of Trade and Commerce, Community Interest Company, helping hands and the Neighbourhood Community Cooking project.

Planning Applications - 35 Planning Applications considered

- 2 applications withdrawn

Castle Site

The Castle site is one of 40 sites across County included in the Cornwall AONB Monumental Improvement project, an initiative to help stabilise 40 Scheduled Monuments which are listed on Historic England's Heritage at Risk register or classified as vulnerable.

Working with landowners, partners and local communities, the project will help to stabilise these important heritage sites to ensure that they can be enjoyed by future generations. The council is hopeful of some funding and guidance on what can be done with the site.

Children's Play Area

The children's play area has new fencing and non-slip matting at the entrance, but getting quotes for any repair work is proving more difficult.

Tintagel Road bus stop and bus shelter

The Bus shelter was given a thorough make over, repainted, cleaned and an impressive image of the harbour installed.

Dog Warden

The council have been delighted that the previous dog warden has reconsidered and will hopefully take the role back on. The council will title the role as "environment officer."

Neighbourhood Development Plan

Following the resignation of the entire committee in May/June the Neighbourhood Development Plan has stalled. With no further activity during the year.

Traffic Regulation Order

The final public consultations by Cornwall Council have been concluded and decisions on the scheme are expected in April 2022.
