Parish Council Report for year April 2016 – March 2017

Meetings - 18 Parish Council meetings convened

- 12 monthly meetings
- 6 planning and/or Staff & Finance meetings
- 1 site meeting
- Councillors have also attended many other meetings including Community Network, Cornwall Council and Environment Agency, Parish Plan group and Boscastle Chamber of Trade and Commerce and Community Interest Company.

Boscastle CIC

The Boscastle Community Interest Company report no major issues with running the public toilets and have this year introduced a community mini bus which has become popular.

Castle Site

The Castle site has given the Parish Council much concern over the year with debates and decisions re river crossings which has been well documented in the Blowhole magazine. The Council agreed to convene a separate meeting to determine the long term plan for the site, which follows on from this Annual Parish Meeting.

Tintagel Road bus stop and bus shelter

The Parish council have this year installed a bus shelter on Tintagel Road. Discussions are ongoing with Cornwall Council re changing the school bus route to Camelford so the shelter can be used by the school children.

Dog Warden

The Volunteer dog warden has dealt with a good number of dog related issues and overall the dog fouling problem appears to be getting under some control.

Neighbourhood Development Plan

Following some planning applications a group is attempting to form a committee to produce a neighbourhood development plan , which if complete Cornwall Council planners would have to take into consideration when deciding on planning applications. The Initial meeting is on Monday 18th April at 8pm in the village hall all those interested are welcome to attend.

Traffic variation Order

The Local Camelford Community Network Panel has been allocated money to use for a Traffic variation Order which will encompass many local communities who need changes. The parish Council have requested and had granted three changes one is around the Doctors surgery to restrict waiting between 8am and 6pm to aid parking for patients, another is on Penally Hill to change the seasonal restriction to all year round from the access to the valley between Valency and Lower Meadows House up the hill and to have all year round restriction from the slip road down to the quarry on New Road. Opportunities for more next year may be available and the parish Council would like to get something further done on New Road.
