

Minutes 8th September 2022

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Present Cllr Hockin, Cllr Yates, Cllr Simmonds CCllr Jordan,

The chair asked all attendees to stand and observe a minute's silence in memory of Queen Elizabeth II.

06.01 Apologies – Cllr Edwards-Symons, Cllr Potter, Cllr Ferrett. Cllr Edwards, Cllr Bridges, Cllr Rodda

06.02 The Chair, due to the lack of councillors, cancelled the meeting as it is inquorate.

The Chair and clerk identified the only real urgent item was payments. The Clerk and Chair agreed for the cheques (all of which had in some way been agreed at previous meetings) to be signed and payments made with decision to be ratified at next meeting.

Member of the public (7) who had attended were offered the opportunity, rather than have a wasted evening, to speak to the councillors present.

The members of the public gave their views and thoughts on the proposed works to Paradise Triangle. All present agreed to works being undertaken to improve the area but felt wildlife should also be respected. The area has over the years grown out of control. It needs tidying up i.e. getting rid of the brambles, sycamores, cut back hydrangea bushes by the road. Take the height down but leave the dense areas for wildlife. There maybe an invasive rhododendron which will need checking. It was thought the Rowen trees had been planted in someone's memory. The grass alongside the path at the back of triangle is encroaching over the path and needs cutting back.

One member also asked about uninhabited houses in the village. CCllr Jordan advised that he was trying to resolve this.

One member raised concerns re the proposed double yellow lines opposite Boscastle House. They were advised the Cornwall Council consultation period had finished. Although they had raised their concerns to Cornwall Council the Parish Council were not made aware.
