Forrabury & Minster Parish Council strongly object to the revision of the proposed 2023 Off-Street Parking Order.

Boscastle Cobweb Car Park is the only Cornwall Council asset in this small village the proposed revision of the order will:

- Severely penalises local people and employees.
 - by increasing the Just Park multi ticket from £1.10 to £3.00. which is used in the main by employees.
 - by introducing 24 hour charging. The 10am to 5pm enable locals to get to the shop/post office etc. This in turn this will impact on local business by minimising early morning local custom.
 - by increasing the season ticket price by 30%. This is used by local residents and will only encourage on street parking and congestion.
- Fails to address the under use of the car park in the winter months.
 - The Parish Council and other local stakeholders want a winter/summer tariff. This would help reduce on street parking and encourage more use of the car park.

The Car Park is a community asset and its running and operation should be influenced by the local community to best suit the needs of visitors, locals and the operator. Rather than a county wide standard that simple just makes the Council officers life easy.
