Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Forrabury & Minster Parish held in the Village Hall on Thursday 24th March at 7pm

Welcome and Apologies: The Chairman welcomed Councillors and members of the public to the meeting. **Apologies** - received from two councillors and the Primary School.

The following reports received

Parish Council – hard copy of report given to all attendees

BCTC – The traders show great resilience during the last year working together to overcome the impact of Covid.

Blowhole Magazine – A busy challenging year, the publication is well received, and the production team are keen to reach out to a younger audience. The cost of production is likely to rise.

Church of England – no representee

Community & Recreation Centre – for the first year the centre has made a loss due to the covid pandemic reducing usage. Grants from Cornwall Council are helping. A New Swipe card system is due to be installed.

Football Club – The club has two teams which is a credit to the community. Very little fund raising had been possible, although the club has strong finances.

Methodist Chapel – no representee

National Trust – the clerk read out a report received.

Play Group – No representee

Primary School – apologies received

Short mat Bowls Club – the club are looking for new members as the Covid pandemic has had a big impact on attendances and membership.

Womens Institute – Really busy year, the old telephone box is now a second hand bookshop which raises approximately £100 per year and contributes to the Defibrillator cost. Twelve new members have joined with evening events due to be started including a gardening club.

Boscastle Community Interest Company – Currently working with Cornwall Council to install electric charging points in the car park. The Toilets will be remodelled to provide a one way in and one way out to minimise paddle gate damage.
